Our Favorites:

- **Doran Beach**- 201 Doran Beach Rd, Bodega Bay, CA 94923
 - \$7 parking fee due to ownership by Sonoma County Regional Parks. Dogs OK on leash. Best beach for children due to calm, safer tide. Wheelchair accessible on wooden boardwalk and other paved areas.
- **North Salmon Creek**- 3095 CA-1, Bodega Bay, CA 94923
 - Very popular and has the most parking out of the state beaches. Great for surfing.
- **Portuguese Beach**- Coast Hwy at Eureka Drive, Bodega Bay, CA 94923
 - Directly across and walk able from Sereno del Mar neighborhood.

Local Rules:

Flora and Fauna are the principal attractions of most state parks. As such they are protected by Federal, State and Park laws.

Firearms and Hunting are not allowed in units of the State Parks System. Possession of loaded firearms or air rifles is prohibited.

Dead/ Dry Wood is part of the natural condition. The gathering of down wood is prohibited.

Fires are permitted only in facilities provided for this purpose. All fireworks are prohibited.

Animals, including cats, cannot be turned loose in park units. Dogs must be on a tended leash no more than 6 feet. Unless posted to the contrary, dogs, other than those that assist the permanently disabled, are prohibited on trails, beaches, and wherever posted.

Vehicles must be confined to designated roads or areas. The speed for all vehicles is 15 miles per hour in areas of general assemblage. Parking is permitted only in designated areas. Blocking parking spaces is prohibited.

Refuse, including garbage, cigarettes, paper boxes, bottles, ashes and other rubbish, shall be placed only in designated receptacles. Your pleasure and pride in your parks will be enhanced when they are kept clean.

PLEASE clean up after yourself so that others may enjoy the beauty of these parks.

Kayaking/ Boating/Fishing:

Hiking:



Pinnacle Gulch, Kortum Trail, Pomo Canyon Trail

- **Bodega Head**- Parking at the end of Westshore Road
 - This 3.0 mile partial loop hike is easy, with about 300 feet in elevation change. There is one short easy uphill stretch, and the rest of the hike is nearly flat. Elevation ranges from 90 to 275 feet. You can split this hike into two, shorter ones -- a 1.1 mile out and back to the overlook, or a 1.8 mile loop through the headlands.

- **Kortum Trail-** Parking at Shell Beach, Bodega Bay, CA 94923
 - Kortum Trail is about 4.3 miles long and starts at a lot located about a 15 minute drive from Bodega Bay.
- **Pinnacle Gulch-** Parking at 20600 Mockingbird Drive, Bodega Bay, CA 94923
 - The steep coastal access trail leads to a spectacular view of hidden coves and rock formations. Fishing is excellent but challenging. A perfect place to spend an enjoyable day for picnicking, sightseeing and relaxation. Can be hiked as a 1.9-mile loop with Shorttail Gulch Trail. Flush restroom facility at parking lot in the South Harbour of Bodega Bay.
- **Pomo Canyon-** Parking at Shell Beach, Bodega Bay, CA 94923
 - Pomo Canyon Campground to Shell Beach is a 6.6 mile out and back trail located near Duncans Mills (20 minute drive from Bodega Bay). The trail is primarily used for hiking and is accessible year-round.
